## 1000 ISLANDS 2023 TREE AND SHRUB SEEDLING SALE

This year, 1000 Islands Environmental Center is holding a tree and shrub seedling sale to offer landowners and homeowners the opportunity to improve and protect the environment while beautifying and increasing the value of their property. Proceeds of the sale are used to fund environmental education programs and events. Thank you to Kaukauna Utilities for sponsoring this seedling sale.

### **TREE SEEDLINGS (10 seedlings per bundle)**

**Eastern White Pine** (*Pinus strobus*) A fast-growing, hardy and adaptable to many soil types. Prefers partial to full sun. The soft wispy needles are clustered in groups of five. Excellent ornamental if sheared lightly. Commonly used as a windbreak, reforestation, shade trees and Christmas trees. Can grow 60-80' high with a 20-40' spread..

**White Spruce** (*Picea glauca*) The white spruce is an evergreen with dense foliage, needles that are blue-green in color and is a long-lived conifer. This conifer grows faster than many other spruces. Commonly found in nature along streams and lakeshores, this spruce is more shade tolerant than most others. A great choice for heavier soils such as clay. Very popular as a Christmas tree, the White Spruce is also naturally deer resistant and provides high wildlife value. Can grow 50-70' high with a 15-20' spread.

**Swamp White Oak** (*Quercus bicolor*) As the name suggests, this oak is found growing wild in low-lying and swampy areas – often moist bottomlands or river banks. But it grows just as well in an urban or suburban setting, with tolerance to compacted soil and (perhaps surprisingly) drought. The swamp white oak is a great choice for a shade or street tree, with the ability to grow at a moderate pace and live more than 300 years. Its leaves are whitish on the underside and green on the top sides and the trees produce acorns that wildlife enjoy. Can grow 60-80' high with a 60-80' spread.

**White Oak** (*Quercus alba*) Rounded, broad-rounded or upright rounded when mature that makes it an ideal shade tree. This is a classic oak tree. Moderate growth each year with small, elongated acorns. Prefer full to partial sun and should be planted in an area where the tree has room to grow and where the root zone will remain undisturbed. Showy, purple-red long lasting foliage. Can grow 60-80' high with a 60-80' spread.

**Red Maple** (*Acer rubrum*): The red maple provides you with red color year round. This tree is very adaptable to most soil types and moisture conditions. Showy red flowers appear in spring, reddish twigs and buds display in winter and the stems on the green leaves are red in summer. The autumn color makes this one of the most popular maple trees. Brilliant ruby red, orange and yellow leaves with red stems adorn the Red Maple tree as temps cool off and days shorten. This is the tree that made fall famous.

### **SHRUB SEEDLINGS (5 seedlings per bundle)**

**American Elderberry Shrub** (*Sambucus canadensis*) The American Elderberry is a large, spreading shrub that flowers in clumps of white early in the season. This shrub produces large clusters of small berries which are edible once autumn arrives. The ripened berries are great for making pie, wine and jam. This shrub is perfect for naturalizing wide open areas such as a farm field, and provides excellent cover for wildlife. This shrub will do very well in wetter areas and is commonly used for effective erosion control along rivers and streams. Can grow 10-15' high with a 10-15' spread.

**Gray Dogwood Shrub** (*Cornus racemosa*) The Gray Dogwood is small to medium sized shrub, typically growing to a height of 6-10'. In spring, creamy white flowers will display for a week to ten days. In late summer, clusters of bluish-white berries will mature. The main stems of this multi-stemmed shrub are gray in color, and the twigs are dark red to purplish-red. This is an excellent choice for wildlife attraction. The Gray Dogwood is one of the most widely adaptable shrubs we know of. This dogwood will

do well on dry upland sites and wetland sites, in full sun to full shade. Commonly found along streams, edges of ponds, along fence rows, roadsides and forest edges. This shrub will spread to form a thicket, so give it a little room to grow. The Gray Dogwood makes an excellent choice for erosion control along slopes and waterways due to its fibrous root system. Can grow 6-10' with a 6-10' spread.

**Nannyberry Viburnum Shrub** (*Viburnum lentago*) Arching branches of glossy green leaves adorn this multi-stem shrub which can be pruned to a single-trunk tree. In late spring, showy flat-topped clustering white flowers attract pollinators. Sweet blue-black autumn berries are tasty fresh. Deep red fall foliage. Berries frequently persist into winter and are enjoyed by many types of birds and small mammals. This versatile viburnum is suitable for many planting applications. Apt to sucker, Nannyberry is excellent for naturalizing in moist areas, near stream banks, or in low wooded areas. Sturdy shrub for borders, hedge, or screen. Can grow 15-25' high with a 6-12' spread.

**Downy Serviceberry Shrub** (*Amelanchier arborea*) This attractive Serviceberry will bring year-round interest to your yard. Early spring brings drooping clusters of 5-petaled, white flowers. Attractive to pollinators, the delicate blooms may last a week or more, if not blown away by the wind. Oblong fine-toothed leaves of bronze-purple emerge after the bloom. Edible dark purplish-black berries resemble blueberries in color, size, and taste. The 3" long leaves turn to dark green in summer. You'll love the brilliant autumn show of red orange. This attractive shrub is also classified as a small tree. The berries produced by the Amelanchier are a favorite of bakers for jam, pies and cobblers. Mature fruit is generally ready for harvest 45 to 60 days after the very early bloom; and typically ripen in late June or early July. Berry crops will generally be available to harvest within 3 to 5 years of planting and will produce an average of 4 to 6 lbs. of berries each season. Can grow 15-25' high with a 15-25' spread.
