

# 1000 Islands Environmental Center

## 2022 Cub Scout Clinic



### Cost: \$8/person (Leaders and parent chaperones are free)

- ❖ Scouts are not registered until payment is received. Unpaid spaces will not be held.
- ❖ Clinics will be set up as a 2 or 2.5-hour program with naturalist led and/or self-led activities.
- ❖ All fees must be paid in advance and registration materials received by the Friday one full week prior to program.
- ❖ Please register as a den. Individual scouts are welcome if your den chooses not to participate.
- ❖ There is no refund for cancellations, but substitutions can be made.
- ❖ Registering for a 1000 Islands Environmental Center Clinic implies consent for use of any photographs taken during the clinic. Leaders/parents must advise 1000 Islands staff at least one week before clinic if there are exceptions.
- ❖ Scouts should dress appropriately in layers for program activities both indoors and outdoors.
- ❖ All children (including non-scout siblings) must pay for the program. This scout program is not appropriate for children under age 6. Siblings over age 6 are welcome unless otherwise noted.
- ❖ There is no cost for leaders or parent chaperones, and scouts must be accompanied by at least the den leader or another representative. Additional adults are welcome to assist scouts through their activities.
- ❖ Leaders will receive certification of requirements completed.
- ❖ Scout leaders must provide awards – no awards will be distributed during this program.
- ❖ Program will be cancelled and fees refunded if the minimum registration is not achieved. Leaders will be notified of cancellation by Wednesday before the program.
- ❖ Leaders may bring snacks for their group – snacks are not provided. Snack time is not calculated into the clinic schedule and leaders should plan accordingly to complete required activities and limit snacks to the last 15-20 minutes of the program.
